

The Quaint Streets of the Village of Adare

The Geraldines of Kildare developed Adare in medieval times and the present village was largely an early 19th century creation by the Dunravens. The building of the Gothic style Adare Manor began in 1831. Adare Village is an architectural wealth of scenic beauty. The main street is punctuated with beautiful stone buildings, medieval monasteries, ruins and picturesque village park. The streets are lined with the original thatched cottages which were built in the 1820s by Lord Dunraven. Some of these cottages have changed use and are now restaurants, fashion boutiques and arts and crafts shops. Located in the heart of County Limerick just 15 minutes south of Limerick City, the Village of Adare is the gateway to the southwest of Ireland, bordering the counties of Kerry, Cork, Clare and Tipperary.

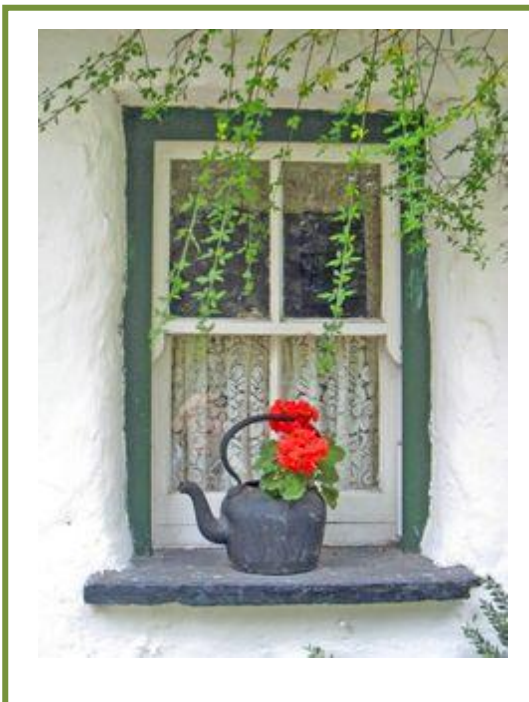
